

From our Pastor's Desk

Dear Family:

Welcome to the month of March and to the last Sunday before the Lenten season begins this coming Wednesday. Today's readings remind us to avoid judging others and to look inwardly examining ourselves before we speak and to avoid gossiping, judging, condemning, or harming the reputation of others by our careless and unbridled utterances. In today's Gospel Jesus gave teachings that remind us to look at ourselves more than others. Once we do that and achieve good changes and free ourselves of evil ways, we will bear much fruit. Thus, bearing good fruit begins with making ourselves good. This requires much self-reflection, self-examination, and a ton of humility. And that is always the hardest part. We all have tendencies to look at everyone before we look at ourselves. It is the other who must be wrong. We have eagle eyes for the mistakes of others while being blind and neglectful of ourselves. We give ourselves all the benefits of the doubt. Understanding, patience, and mercy are always available to self.

Jesus condemns our careless, malicious and rash judgments about the behavior, feelings, motives or actions of others by using the funny examples of one blind man leading another blind man and one man with a log stuck in his eye, trying to remove a tiny speck from another's eye. Each one of us has had experiences of saying things we deeply regretted later, but by then, the harm has already been done. Even though we may revoke our words, the initial damage or harm may not be reversed. In marriage and in our relationships, we often say abominable and hurtful things when there is a conflict or misunderstanding only to regret them later. We judge others a lot. We complain about what we suffer from others without thinking about what they suffer from us.

For Jesus, the above attitude is not productive. Change, if needed, will not happen. Why? Because the other who is the object of criticism is also looking at us and is doing the same. In other words, we see each other's defects, but we do not see our own. And when we do not see our own defects, change will not happen. Change begins with self. Rarely does one change because of the other. In most cases, we are offended. If and when we admit our defects, change comes very gradually or minimally.

But if we heed Jesus' call to focus more on ourselves, change will be immediate and widespread. If I look at myself, see my defects, admit their presence in me, understand the need to change them, and finally decide to address them, change will happen. If everyone is taking the same approach, change happens to everyone quickly.

Jesus did not mean that we cannot criticize each other. No one sees everything. We all have our blind side. Jesus was stressing the fact that humility is basic. Learning to humble ourselves opens ourselves to the concern of others. The combination of self-criticism and fraternal correction is a perfect recipe for becoming a good person. And, as the Gospel says, "A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good fruits."

We should avoid judging others because no one except God is good enough to judge others; only God sees the whole truth, and only He can read the human heart. Hence, only He has the ability, right and authority to judge us. We do not see all the facts or circumstances or the power of the temptation which has led a person to do something evil. We are often prejudiced in our judgment of others, and total fairness cannot be expected from us, especially when we are judging those near or dear to us. We have no right to judge because we have the same faults as the one we are judging and often in a greater degree (remember Jesus' funny example of a man with a log in his eye trying to remove the dust particle View this bulletin online at www.DiscoverMass.com

from another's eye). Abraham Lincoln said that the only one who has the right to criticize is the one who has the heart to help. Hence, we should leave all judgment to God, practice mercy and forgiveness, and pray for God's grace to get rid of all forms of hypocrisy in our lives. We need to withdraw to our inner selves to examine our lives properly as Christians and cultivate internal peacefulness, love, and understanding that will motivate our inner thoughts and words.

Finally, the second reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians, reminds us why goodness should be maintained. The sting of death is sin. Goodness and holiness defang death. Not that we will not die physically but life eternal is the fruit awaiting.

Dear brothers and sisters, the season of Lent begins this coming Wednesday with the distribution of ashes. The following is the schedule for Masses that day: 7:00 am in English, 8:30 am in English, 12:00 Noon in Spanish, 6:00 pm in English and 8:00 pm in Spanish. We will have a Service with Ashes at 4:00 pm in Spanish. Also, as part of the season of Lent, we are adding one more day of confessions a week. The following is the weekly schedule for confessions during Lent: Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 5:15 to 6:45 pm and Saturday from 8:30 to 10:00 am. We also will hear confessions by appointment either calling me or Fr. Saul.

On another subject, I would like to share that we now have an image of St. Charbel Makhlof in our parish. The image is located next to the image of Our Lady of Schoenstatt behind the portable and in front of the St. Michael the Archangel's Blessed Sacrament Chapel. St. Charbel is one of the most active saints in our faith and he is well known for his powerful intercession for the sick. Alleged miracles through his intercession include healings from cancer, stroke, cysts, and the healing of a premature baby. St. Charbel was canonized by Pope St. Paul VI on October 9, 1977. His feast day is July 24th.

We must remember that we are to love one another as God has loved us. Doing so will make us **One Body, One Spirit, One Family!** Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Katharine Drexel, Saint Michael the Archangel, Pope Saint Pius X, St. Charbel and Saint Dr. Jose Gregorio Hernandez, pray for us.

Del Escritorio de Nuestro Párroco

Querida familia:

Bienvenidos al mes de marzo y al último domingo antes de que comience la temporada de Cuaresma el próximo miércoles. Las lecturas de hoy nos recuerdan que debemos evitar juzgar a los demás y examinarnos anteriormente antes de hablar y evitar chismear, juzgar, condenar o dañar la reputación de los demás con nuestras expresiones descuidadas y desenfrenadas. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús dio enseñanzas que nos recuerdan que debemos mirarnos a nosotros mismos más que a los demás. Una vez que hagamos eso y logremos buenos cambios y nos liberemos de los malos caminos, daremos mucho fruto. Por lo tanto, dar buen fruto comienza por hacernos buenos a nosotros mismos. Esto requiere mucha autorreflexión, autoexamen y mucha humildad. Y esa es siempre la parte más difícil. Todos tenemos tendencias a mirar a todos antes de mirarnos a nosotros mismos. Es el otro quien debe estar equivocado. Tenemos ojos de águila para los errores de los demás mientras somos ciegos y descuidados con nosotros mismos. Nos damos todos los beneficios de la duda. La comprensión, la paciencia y la misericordia siempre están disponibles para nosotros.

Jesús condena nuestros juicios descuidados, maliciosos y precipitados sobre el comportamiento, los sentimientos, los motivos o las acciones de los demás utilizando los divertidos ejemplos de un ciego que guía a otro ciego y de un hombre con una viga clavada en el ojo, tratando de sacar una pequeña mota del ojo de otro. Cada uno de nosotros ha tenido experiencias de decir cosas de las que luego nos arrepentimos profundamente, pero para entonces, el daño ya está hecho. Aunque podamos retractarnos de nuestras palabras, es posible que el daño o perjuicio inicial no se revierta. En el matrimonio y en nuestras relaciones, a menudo decimos cosas abominables e hirientes cuando hay un conflicto o un malentendido, solo para arrepentirnos de ellas más tarde. Juzgamos mucho a los demás. Nos quejamos de lo que sufrimos de los demás sin pensar en lo que ellos sufren por nosotros.

Para Jesús, la actitud anterior no es productiva. El cambio, si es necesario, no ocurrirá. ¿Por qué? Porque el otro que es objeto de crítica también nos está mirando y está haciendo lo mismo. En otras palabras, vemos los defectos del otro, pero no vemos los nuestros. Y cuando no vemos nuestros propios defectos, el cambio no ocurrirá. El cambio empieza por uno mismo. Rara vez uno cambia por el otro. En la mayoría de los casos, nos sentimos ofendidos. Si admitimos nuestros defectos, el cambio se produce muy gradual o mínimamente.

Pero si atendemos al llamado de Jesús a centrarnos más en nosotros mismos, el cambio será inmediato y generalizado. Si me miro a mí mismo, veo mis defectos, admito su presencia en mí, comprendo la necesidad de cambiarlos y finalmente decido abordarlos, el cambio se producirá. Si todos adoptan el mismo enfoque, el cambio se produce en todos rápidamente.

Jesús no quiso decir que no podemos criticarnos unos a otros. Nadie lo ve todo. Todos tenemos nuestro lado ciego. Jesús estaba enfatizando el hecho de que la humildad es básica. Aprender a humillarnos nos abre a la preocupación de los demás. La combinación de autocritica y corrección fraterna es una receta perfecta para convertirse en una buena persona. Y, como dice el Evangelio, "El hombre bueno dice cosas buenas, porque el bien está en su corazón".

Debemos evitar juzgar a los demás porque nadie excepto Dios es lo suficientemente bueno para juzgar a los demás; solo Dios ve toda la verdad y solo Él puede leer el corazón humano. Por lo tanto, sólo Él tiene la capacidad, el derecho y la autoridad para juzgarnos. No vemos todos

los hechos o circunstancias ni el poder de la tentación que ha llevado a una persona a hacer algo malo. A menudo somos prejuiciosos al juzgar a los demás, y no se puede esperar de nosotros una imparcialidad total, especialmente cuando estamos juzgando a personas cercanas o queridas para nosotros. No tenemos derecho a juzgar porque tenemos los mismos defectos que la persona a la que estamos juzgando y, a menudo, en mayor grado (recuerde el divertido ejemplo de Jesús del hombre con una viga en el ojo que intentaba quitar la partícula de polvo del ojo de otro). Abraham Lincoln dijo que el único que tiene derecho a criticar es el que tiene el corazón para ayudar. Por lo tanto, debemos dejar todo juicio a Dios, practicar la misericordia y el perdón, y orar por la gracia de Dios para deshacerse de todas las formas de hipocresía en nuestras vidas. Necesitamos retirarnos a nuestro ser interior para examinar adecuadamente nuestras vidas como cristianos y cultivar la paz interior, el amor y la comprensión que motivarán nuestros pensamientos y palabras interiores. Finalmente, la segunda lectura de la Carta de San Pablo a los Corintios, nos recuerda por qué se debe mantener la bondad. El agujón de la muerte es el pecado. La bondad y la santidad desgarran la muerte. No es que no moriremos físicamente, pero la vida eterna es el fruto que nos espera.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, el tiempo de Cuaresma comienza este próximo miércoles con la distribución de cenizas. El siguiente es el horario de las Misas de ese día: 7:00 am en inglés, 8:30 am en inglés, 12:00 mediodía en español, 6:00 pm en inglés y 8:00 pm en español. Tendremos un Servicio con Cenizas a las 4:00 pm en español. Además, como parte del tiempo de Cuaresma, estamos agregando un día más de confesiones a la semana. El siguiente es el horario semanal de confesiones durante la Cuaresma: lunes, miércoles y viernes de 5:15 a. 6:45 pm y sábados de 8:30 a 10:00 am. También escucharemos confesiones con cita previa, ya sea llamándome a mí o al Padre Saul.

Hablando de otro tema, me gustaría compartir con ustedes que ahora tenemos una imagen de San Charbel Makhlof en nuestra parroquia. La imagen está ubicada al lado de la imagen de Nuestra Señora de Schoenstatt detrás del portable y frente a la Capilla del Santísimo Sacramento San Miguel Arcángel. San Charbel es uno de los santos más activos en nuestra fe y es muy conocido por su poderosa intercesión por los enfermos. Los supuestos milagros a través de su intercesión incluyen curaciones de cáncer, derrame cerebral, quistes y la curación de un bebé prematuro. San Charbel fue canonizado por el Papa San Pablo VI el 9 de octubre de 1977. Su fiesta es el 24 de julio.

Recordemos que debemos amarnos los unos a los otros como Dios nos ha amado. Haciéndolo seremos **¡Un Cuerpo, Un Espíritu, Una Familia!** Santísima Virgen María, Santa Katharine Drexel, San Miguel Arcángel, Papa San Pío X, San Charbel y San Dr. Jose Gregorio Hernandez, rueguen por nosotros.



In both parts together we experience God and participate in a single integrated act of worship. It is through hearing the word of God that we believe in sharing the bread of life and through sharing the bread of life that we are empowered to live the word of God.






