



From our Pastor's Desk

Dear Family:

We have entered into the Season of Lent once again. In the 2025 Order of Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours and Celebration of the Eucharist (ORDO), we read, "The annual Lenten season is the fitting time to climb the holy mountain of Easter. The Lenten season has a double character, namely, to prepare both catechumens (those getting prepared for baptism) and faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery. The catechumens, both with the rite of election and scrutinies, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian initiation; the faithful, ever more attentive to the word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises."

In this first weekend of Lent, we are invited to go into the desert with Jesus: to share both his conflict and his victory; to discover our own weaknesses and temptations; to know the depth of our reliance on God's grace. And the purpose is for a genuine conversion to occur. The liturgy of the word invites us to meditate on the temptations of Jesus, which show us how to remain focused in our call as Christians and in our faithfulness to God the Father who is always faithful.

Jesus spent forty days in the desert overcoming the devil, and Lent is a time for us to get rid of whatever bit of the devil remains in us by overcoming sin in our lives. But Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, knows that the solution to life's problems cannot be found in quick spectacles or manipulative power. Jesus discovers, by contending with the devil and sending the devil away, that his calling is not to be a superstar, but to be a servant. His ministry is not to wear a crown but to carry a cross. So, let us take a look at each temptation and see how it applies to us too.

The first temptation of Jesus shows us how we are also tempted by our human appetite – our passion and desires. Jesus has the power to do whatever he wills, and he was tempted in this regard to use his power to turn stones to bread for his own pleasure. We too face similar temptation to use what we have to satisfy the desires of our flesh. We trade our beauty for sexual immorality; our intelligence for fraud; our power for oppression; our wealth for intimidation.

The second temptation concerns the acquisition of wealth, success, honor, and power. This is the reason why people join occult, evil groups. In whom is our security most sure if not God? People could do anything for wealth. Some could sell their body in prostitution for wealth; others could sell others and even kill others for wealth and success.

The third temptation of Jesus concerns the presumption of divine favor. We assume that we are entitled to receive goodness and richness, just because we are children of God. Many believe that "If you are a Christian or Catholic..." you should not be poor! You should not suffer! You should not have difficulties with your job, marriage, education, relationship, business, and more. Hence, we start looking for God where we ought not to.

Chances are that the evil one will not tempt us with such grand enticements. Nevertheless, we face temptations daily. One of the temptations we face today is the urge many people feel to fight change, especially change in the church. Look at it, none of us like change and yet change is about the only thing we can count on to be permanent. Things change, things have changed, and things will always change. The church has changed, is changing and will continue to change and yet there are many who just like to hang on to the past, to the known, to the familiar. And as long as that fist is clenched, holding tightly to the past, what can God put into it? We forget so quickly that only one does not change, and it is God himself. He is eternal; we are temporal and constantly changing.

We overcome Satan by putting God first in our lives in every way. The three quotations from Deuteronomy cited by Jesus when talking with Satan in today's Gospel remind us of putting God first in everything. They are, "It is written, One does not live on bread alone" "It is written, you shall worship the Lord, your God, and him alone shall you serve." "It also says, you shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test."

Beloved in Christ, every day we are confronted with temptations, but our faith should not be shaken. Even in the face of temptations, we should be able to stand firm and show our belief in God. The second reading assures us that, "No one who believes in him (God) would be put to shame... everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved." So let us trust in our heavenly father and we shall triumph over every temptation.

On a side note, I would like to remind you of the schedule for general confessions during this season of Lent: Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 5:15 to 6:45 pm and Saturdays from 8:30 to 10:00 am. Keep in mind that if this schedule does not work for you, you may request an appointment for confession with either me, at extension 215 or with Fr. Saul at extension 222. Our main phone number is (954) 389-5003.

Del Escritorio de Nuestro Párroco

Querida familia:

Hemos entrado de nuevo en el tiempo de Cuaresma. En el Orden de Oración en la Liturgia de las Horas y Celebración de la Eucaristía (ORDO) del 2025, leemos: "El tiempo de Cuaresma anual es el momento oportuno para subir al monte santo de la Pascua. El tiempo de Cuaresma tiene un doble carácter, es decir, preparar tanto a los catecúmenos (aquellos que se preparan para el bautismo) como a los fieles para celebrar el misterio pascual. Los catecúmenos, tanto con el rito de la elección y los escrutinios, como por la catequesis, se preparan para la celebración de los sacramentos de iniciación cristiana; los fieles, cada vez más atentos a la palabra de Dios y a la oración, se preparan mediante la penitencia para la renovación de sus promesas bautismales".

En este primer fin de semana de Cuaresma, estamos invitados a ir al desierto con Jesús: para compartir tanto su conflicto como su victoria; para descubrir nuestras propias debilidades y tentaciones; para conocer la profundidad de nuestra confianza en la gracia de Dios. Y el propósito es que se produzca una conversión genuina. La liturgia de la palabra nos invita a meditar sobre las tentaciones de Jesús, que nos muestran cómo mantenernos centrados en nuestro llamado como cristianos y en nuestra fidelidad a Dios Padre que es siempre fiel.

Jesús pasó cuarenta días en el desierto venciendo al diablo, y la Cuaresma es un tiempo para que nos deshagamos de lo que quede del diablo en nosotros venciendo el pecado en nuestras vidas. Pero Jesús, lleno del Espíritu Santo, sabe que la solución a los problemas de la vida no se encuentra en espectáculos rápidos ni en el poder manipulador. Jesús descubre, al luchar contra el diablo y echarlo, que su llamado no es ser una superestrella, sino ser un servidor. Su ministerio no es llevar una corona sino llevar una cruz. Así que, echemos un vistazo a cada tentación y veamos cómo se aplica a nosotros también.

La primera tentación de Jesús nos muestra cómo también somos tentados por nuestro apetito humano: nuestra pasión y nuestros deseos. Jesús tiene el poder de hacer lo que quiera, y en este sentido fue tentado a usar su poder para convertir las piedras en pan para su propio placer. Nosotros también enfrentamos una tentación similar de usar lo que tenemos para satisfacer los deseos de nuestra carne. Nuestra belleza para la inmoralidad sexual; nuestra inteligencia para el fraude; nuestro poder para la opresión; nuestra riqueza para la intimidación.

La segunda tentación se refiere a la adquisición de riqueza, éxito, honor y poder. Esta es la razón por la cual hay personas que se unen a grupos ocultos y diabólicos. ¿En quién está más segura nuestra seguridad si no es en Dios? Las personas podrían hacer cualquier cosa por riqueza. Algunos podrían vender su cuerpo en prostitución por riqueza; otros podrían vender a otros e incluso matar a otros por riqueza y éxito.

La tercera tentación de Jesús se refiere a la presunción del favor divino. Asumimos que tenemos derecho a recibir bondad y riqueza, solo porque somos hijos de Dios. Muchos creen que "Si

eres cristiano o católico..." ¡no deberías ser pobre! ¡No deberías sufrir! No deberías tener dificultades con tu trabajo, matrimonio, educación, relación, negocios y más. Por eso, empezamos a buscar a Dios donde no debemos hacerlo.

Es probable que el maligno no nos tiente con tan grandes tentaciones. Sin embargo, enfrentamos tentaciones a diario. Una de las tentaciones que enfrentamos hoy es la urgencia que sienten muchas personas de luchar contra el cambio, especialmente el cambio en la iglesia. La verdad es que a ninguno de nosotros nos gusta el cambio y, sin embargo, el cambio es lo único en lo que podemos confiar que será constante. Las cosas cambian, las cosas han cambiado y las cosas siempre cambiarán. La iglesia ha cambiado, está cambiando y seguirá cambiando y, sin embargo, hay muchos a quienes les gusta aferrarse al pasado, a lo conocido, a lo familiar. Y mientras ese puño esté cerrado, aferrándose con fuerza al pasado, ¿qué puede poner Dios en él? Olvidamos tan rápidamente que solo hay uno que no cambia, y es Dios mismo. Él es eterno; nosotros somos temporales y cambiamos constantemente.

Vencemos a Satanás poniendo a Dios primero en nuestras vidas en todos los sentidos. Las tres citas de Deuteronomio citadas por Jesús cuando hablaba con Satanás en el Evangelio de hoy nos recuerdan que debemos poner a Dios primero en todo. Ellas son, "Está escrito: No sólo de pan vive el hombre", "Está escrito: Adoraras al Señor, tu Dios, y a él sólo servirás". "También está escrito: No tentarás al Señor, tu Dios".

Amados en Cristo, cada día nos enfrentamos a tentaciones, pero nuestra fe no debe tambalearse. Incluso ante las tentaciones, debemos poder mantenernos firmes y demostrar nuestra fe en Dios. La segunda lectura nos asegura que "Ninguno que crea en él (Dios) quedará defraudado... todo el que invoque al Señor como a su Dios, será salvado por él." Así que confiemos en nuestro Padre celestial y triunfaremos sobre toda tentación.

Por otra parte, me gustaría recordarles el horario de las confesiones generales durante este tiempo de Cuaresma: lunes, miércoles y viernes de 5:15 a 6:45 pm y sábados de 8:30 a 10:00 am. Tengan en cuenta que, si este horario no le conviene, puede solicitar una cita para confesión conmigo, llamando a la extensión 215 o con el Padre Saul llamando a la extensión 222. 

Introductory Rites



The introductory rites are meant to form a scattered group of people into a single community and to create in that community a frame of mind appropriate to hearing God's word and sharing the bread that is his Son.

The introductory rites consist of the gathering song, the veneration of the altar and greeting, the penitential rite, the Kyrie, the Gloria, and the opening prayer.

The penitential rite is omitted if the rite of blessing and sprinkling holy water is used, the Kyrie is omitted if a particular form of the penitential rite is used, and the Gloria is omitted during Advent and Lent. Nevertheless, this is a heavy weight of introductory material.

Celebrating faith and being challenged to live in response to it is a weighty business, however, and one that may indeed call for a good bit of introduction.

Ritos Introductorios

El acto penitencial se omite si se usa el rito de bendición y aspersión con agua bendita. El Kyrie se omite si se emplea una forma particular del acto penitencial, y el Gloria se omite durante el Adviento y la Cuaresma. No obstante, este conjunto de elementos introductorios tiene un gran peso.

Celebrar la fe y aceptar el desafío de vivir de acuerdo con ella es un compromiso profundo, que muchas veces requiere una introducción significativa.
